Jim Schmidt was contacted by Rob Steinhofer from E3 Coalition, LLC with a proposal for a Focus on Energy Incentive for improving the energy efficiency of our Legion Hall. The proposed cost of the project after the Focus on Energy Incentive was \$241.00. Since all of the specifics of the Incentive were not understood at the regular meeting, the body recommended that Gary Hess and Charles Nelson meet with Rob and due a walk through to understand all of the proposed changes. Gary Hess, Charles Nelson, and Jim Schmidt met with Rob and made the decision to move forward with the Proposal. The estimated yearly energy savings is \$375.00.
