
Freedom Honor Flight - September 21, 2013

Flag Display Cases available at the Vernon County Veterans Service Office



Constructed of rich mahogany colored hardwood and inserted with thick glass each display case holds up to a 5' x 9.6' cotton flag. A die-cast, gold-plated United States Armed Forces medallion is centered onbod a bevel-cut double-mat. Easy open back panel and felt lined, scratch resistant bottom. Available with or without a 5' x 9.6' embroidered cotton Interment flag which is identical to those manufactured for the Veterans Administration. Manufactured in the U.S.A. Outside dimensions: 26" x 13" x 3.5". The cost is \$30.00 for the regular ones and \$40.00 for Military specific ones.
