Hope to see a lot of you at the November Post Meeting!



# VA to expand coverage for contaminated Camp Lejeune drinking water

The Department of Veterans Affairs expects up to 15,000 seriously ill veterans who served at Camp Lejeune, N.C., before 1988, when base drinking water was contaminated, to be helped by a faster-track compensation process proposed last month. Eight medical conditions afflicting vets who served at Lejeune from Aug. 1, 1953, through Dec. 31, 1987, are to be presumed the result of exposure to carcinogens and other harmful chemicals that fouled base water systems. The proposed "presumptive" diseases are: kidney cancer, liver cancer, non-Hodgkin lymphoma, leukemia, multiple myeloma, scleroderma, Parkinson's disease and aplastic anemia/myelodysplastic syndromes.

More information for Camp Lejeune veterans and survivors is online at: Caution-www.publichealth.va.gov/exposures/camp-lejeune/. VA continues to review Camp Lejeune claims. However, for claims that would be denied under current regulations, decisions are being stayed until new regulations are made final.
