Building & Grounds Planning Committee: The members of this new committee are Wes Guy, Harlan Helseth, and Gary Grethel. The purpose of the committee is to keep a list of any item, big or small, that that has been discussed previously or recently, and prioritize them in an appropriate way based upon needs, resources, etc. For the items that boil to the top of the list, the committee will research what the actual need is, outline exactly what will be required, and put together a definitive request for quote that can be given to any contractor so Post 116 is ensured to get back comparable quotes. No item will move forward without body approval. The committee will report at each monthly meeting. One of the first items being looked at is the replacement of the blinds in our Post.

Canoe Race will be August 28, 2021.

August 29 – Post 116 will host a breakfast for the community, which will also ensure the canoe race clean-up volunteers can be fueled up for a hard day's work if they so choose.

Trout Fest will be June 19, 2021. Non-food vendors will use the Legion Hall for their tables.

Coon Creek Area Veterans Memorial: The hope was to be able to have the statue of the soldier placed back at the Memorial in time for Memorial Day this year. Unfortunately, this will not be possible. Everything is moving forward with the replacement of the soldier and the walls that were damaged, with the proofs being approved at the beginning of May.

The Coon Valley American Legion approved donating \$500 this year to the Village of Coon Valley for the purpose of replacing worn flags and hardware that are displayed on highway 14/61. This is a standing motion for Post 116, to donate each year to this purpose, in an amount up to \$500 based upon the need.

Landscaping: Post 116 will continue to need help removing the old landscaping mulch, down to the fabric, and replacing with new mulch. This needs to be completed before Memorial Day. Some of the existing mulch is over 10 years old, and could basically be considered 5 to 6 inches of dirt. Do not just place the new mulch over the existing. There is a large pile of mulch to use, once an area has been cleaned, next to the Veterans Memorial. The old mulch/dirt needs to be loaded up and hauled to the Village of Coon Valley compost area.
